

Biopsy Care Instructions

- 1. Remove our dressing in 24 hours.
- 2. Clean the wound with a gentle cleanser and water once a day.
- Then apply Vaseline, Aquaphor, or CeraVe Healing Ointment to the area once a day.
- 4. Apply a fresh bandage after each cleaning.
- 5. Keep the area covered for the first 7-14 days to promote better healing. This may take longer if the wound is on the lower legs.
- 6. You make take extra strength Tylenol if needed for discomfort.
- 7. You may have some drainage from the wound especially in the first few days; however, if it becomes infected or you have any difficulties, please call our office.

Supplies needed:

- *Cotton tipped applicators (Q-tips)
- *Vaseline, Aguaphor, or CeraVe Healing Ointment (NOT NEOSPORIN)
- *Band-aids, **non-stick** gauze pads and paper tape.

*If you have had a biopsy of a lesion sent for pathology, please know that the results can take up to 2 weeks to receive. We do not call with benign results unless specifically requested.
